## 3. Minutes of Meeting:

## 4. Finance report:

Brian reported that we have received the audited accounts and no problems were identified. There was no fee this time.

Currently the accounts stand as £3156.92 in total.

The precept needs to be set by the end of January 2014. This will be discussed at the January meeting.

## 5. Matters of Report

- **Highways:** Christopher Le Hardy has informed the committee that the Highways agency will carry out the work on the Puckington road by the end of March 2014. Funding has been agreed.
- **Snow clearing:** AON, insurers have sent a letter clarifying that the parish council are not covered for spreading salt on the roads, nor for clearing snow. Salt can be distributed to villagers for their use. Brian will pick up this year's salt allocation when it is available.
- **Crime Report:**  
There has been reports of a car coming through the village late at night – causing a disturbance. Unfortunately to date no one has managed to get the registration number.
- **New Standing orders.** The new publication of standing orders costs £40. Ali will check to see if these are available on line and if so we will not purchase them.

## 6. Correspondence

Brian read out Derek Yeoman's newsletter. It was noted that Somerset spend £25 – 30 million on road maintenance each year.

RNAS Yeovilton are now sending weekly bulletins of their night time activities.

Kay Elston is the new secretary of the charity – Ilchester Relief in need.
