Minutes of Annual Parish Council Meeting

Held at 8.00 p.m. Monday, 12^h May, 2014 in the Village Hall

1. Welcome and Apologies

2. Minutes of last Annual Parish Council Meeting held on 13th May, 2013 were taken as read. There were no objections.

3. Chairman's Report was presented by Brian Faulkner outlining the activities of the Council over the past year including:

- Highways: flooding both ends of the village with associated bank slips in surrounding lanes and mass of potholes had been an issue throughout the winter. Road closure to Ilminster from Langport created problems with increased traffic thru the village
- Thankful village bike run visited Stocklinch and presented the church with a plaque and a certificate for the Parish Council recognising the men from Stocklinch who served in both world wars.

4. Village Hall Committee Rob Rainbow, Village Hall Chairman, presented the annual report stating the hall was in good repair and had been well used throughout the year and emphasised the following issues:

- ❖ sound system upgraded with two speakers added to the rear of the building, plus blinds installed on the top windows.
- ❖ the committee to investigate improved heating and acoustic installations.
- ❖ Solar panels on the village hall proving to be very efficient and yielding a very satisfactory income; additional revenue of £1200 expected from the Dillington estate.

5. Finance Report was presented by the Clerk. We closed the financial year ended 31/3/14 with a balance of £2828.95 made up as follows:

- £ 2604.39 reserve account
- £ 224.56 current account.

It was proposed by Rosie Gallagher and seconded by Alan Speed that the accounts as presented, be adopted.
