Minutes of Annual Parish Council Meeting

Held at 8.00 p.m. Monday, 13th May, 2013 in the Village Hall

1. Welcome and Apologies

2. Minutes of last Annual Parish Council Meeting held on 8th May, 2012 were taken as read. There were no objections.

3. Chairman's Report was presented by Mr. Brian Faulkner outlining the activities of the Council over the past year. The solar panel farm at Whitelackington had caused much concern among many villagers but despite a vigorous defence by the action committee the application had been passed. Owing to boundary changes we had lost a good friend in Councillor Derek Yeomans. His past efforts on our behalf to obtain funding had been much valued.

4. Village Hall Committee Rob Rainbow, Village Hall Chairman, presented the annual report. He advised it had been a successful year and that owing to the adverse visual impact of the array at the Dillington Estate solar farm on the south of Stocklinch, it had been agreed with Lord Cameron that as soon as the panels are in place the village hall committee will receive an annual income of £1,200 for 25 years

5. Finance Report was presented by the Clerk. We closed the financial year ended 31/3/13 with a balance of £2845.75 made up as follows:

- £ 2603.08 reserve account
- £ 242.67 current account.

It was proposed by Rosie Gallagher and seconded by Rob Rainbow that the accounts as presented, be adopted.

6. Chairman Election: Rosie Gallagher proposed that Brian Faulkner, subject to his approval, continue as Chairman for the coming year. This was seconded by Rob Rainbow. Brian agreed to stand as Chairman and the motion was carried. Ros Harding stated she was willing to undertake Vice-Chairperson for the upcoming year.
