## 5. Planning Application N: 13/00857/FUL:

**Applicant:** Dillington Estate

**Proposal:** Vary Condition 02 and 03 planning permission to change layout and tree planting,

**Location:** Parsonage Solar Farm, Stocklinch Rd., Whitelackington

The above application was discussed. Wendy Lutley provided a copy of a report she had submitted to the Planning Officer and asked that the Parish Council endorse her views, including original planting plan/hedge/grassland management regime; revised eastern planting belt; appropriate management of grassland beneath and between the panels and restoration conditions in 25 years be enforced. It was noted that reduction in the extent of panels to the west was to be welcomed. All present agreed with Wendy's report and Ursula said she would e-mail the Planning Officer endorsing these comments.

Brian reported the verges in the village had been cut and that the drainage problem at the Puckington turn had been addressed by the council. Ros reported that the tree recently planted at this junction needed replacing.
